Barre work (one side only) include: plies, tendu, ronde de jambe a terre, adagio and stretch demonstrating range of motion. Center work include: pirouette, petit allegro, grand allegro. Center pointe include: echappes, releves in passe & arabesque, pirouettes, turns across the floor. A solo variation may be added at the end of your DVD.
